

Article 1: Name and Purpose

The Mahananda Social Welfare Foundation (the "Foundation") is a non-profit organization established to promote the welfare and well-being of marginalized communities, with a focus on:

- Health
- Education
- Food management
- Child and women protection
- Employment opportunities
- Helping needy people
- Environmental programs
- Crowd funding

Article 2: Objectives

The objectives of the Foundation are:

- To provide access to quality healthcare and education
- To promote food security and sustainable livelihoods
- To protect the rights and dignity of children and women
- To create employment opportunities and support economic empowerment
- To provide humanitarian aid and support to vulnerable populations
- To promote environmental sustainability and conservation

Article 3: Beneficiaries

The beneficiaries of the Foundation shall include:

- Marginalized communities, including low-income families, children, women, and individuals with disabilities
- Vulnerable populations, including refugees, orphans, and victims of natural disasters or conflicts

Article 4: Foundation Property

The Foundation property shall include all assets, funds, and resources donated, granted, or bequeathed to the Foundation.

Article 5: Management

The Foundation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees (the "Board") comprising [number] individuals with expertise in relevant fields.

Article 6: Powers and Duties

The Board shall have the power to:

Article 10: Amendments

These Terms and Conditions may be amended by the Board, provided that any amendments are in furtherance of the objectives of the Foundation.

Article 11: Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, the Foundation property shall be transferred to another organization with similar objectives, as determined by the Board.

Article 12: Governing Law

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Maharashtra.
